POLARIS RANGER CHAINSAW MOUNT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Unthread the bolt from the aluminum cone expanders. (FIG 1)
- 2. Slide the M8x80 bolt and washer you removed in step 1 through the aluminum L bracket in the side with the single hole. (FIG 2)
- 3. Pick an attachment hole on the bed rail that you would like to locate the Chainsaw mount. Slide in the aluminum cone expanders into the hole. (FIG 3) Press down so the top of the top expander is flush with the bed rail.
- 4. Using a 13mm T-handle or socket, tighten the bolt and the aluminum cone expanders will come together to expand the rubber inside the bed rail hole. Tighten until you feel the two aluminum cone expanders come together and become tight. (FIG 4)
- 5. Line up the chainsaw mount to the L bracket with 1 row of the 3 slotted mounting holes. By hand slide the M6x16 button head bolts along with provided washers through the chainsaw mount and L bracket. (FIG 5) Use the 6mm nylon lock nuts on the backside of both button head bolts. Tighten using a 4mm Allen wrech and 10mm wrench. (FIG 6)
- 6. With the chainsaw strap hanging loose of the front of the chainsaw mount, slide the chainsaw into the scabbard. (FIG 7)
- 7. Slide the chainsaw strap up over the chainsaw near the handle. Tighten the chainsaw strap to secure the chainsaw. (FIG 8)
- 8. Have fun and enjoy your next project!
