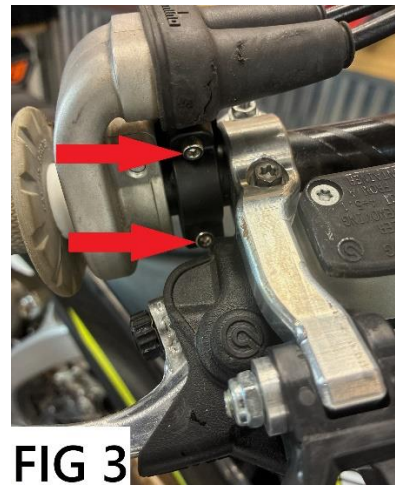
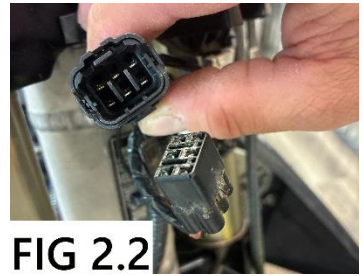
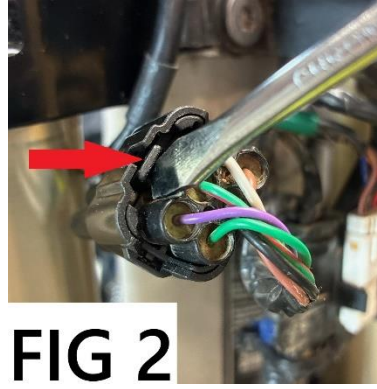


1. Remove headlight mask or front number plate on the motorcycle.
2. Follow the wire from the OEM Start/Stop button to the connection at the front of the motorcycle. First, remove the connector from the plastic holder. (FIG 1)(FIG 1.2) Then, lift the tab with your thumb nail or screw driver and disconnect the coupler. (FIG 2) (Fig 2.2)
3. Remove any zip ties or tape holding the OEM starter button wire to the handlebar.
4. Using 3mm Allen wrench remove the OEM Start/Stop button. (FIG 3)
5. Plug in the EE Start/Stop button connector into the lead on the motorcycle where the OEM one was disconnected in step 2.
6. Run the buttons up to the handlebar on the desired side. Either button will run to either side of the handlebar.
7. Wrap the EE button straps around the handlebar and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. These should be snug and not over tightened. (FIG 4)
8. Be sure to wrap any wires with cable ties to prevent snagging on something during a ride.
9. Reinstall the headlight mask or front number plate.
10. Have fun and enjoy your next ride.
